



Internships in Educational Assessment and Evaluation

The Association for the Cooperative Advancement of Science and Education (ACASE.org) is an independent association of scientists and teachers. Since its founding in the 1990's, ACASE has passed through 3 historic stages, each one emerging organically out of its predecessor:

1. The study and promotion of scientific creativity in educational programs
2. The development of alternatives to destructive assessment and evaluation practices in education (i.e. conventional testing and grading practices)
3. The development of information science and technology in direct support of educational events

Qualifications

ACASE is presently seeking interns who possess or can develop skills in the following areas (a premium will be placed on individuals who have substantial experience in teaching and curriculum development):

- social media
- statistical learning/data science/data analysis using R
- design and management of online courses
- database management
- educational data analysis
- technical writing
- public presentation

The Internships

- A. One or more interns will be hired to fulfill all of the functions outlined in the qualifications.
- B. Interns will be intimately involved in the design, conduct, analysis and public presentation of research and development efforts, and in professional development activities. They will work primarily with the director but also with other ACASE associates. Interns will develop high-level skills in educational assessment and evaluation working on a variety of challenges and projects in a collaborative and supportive atmosphere.
- C. ACASE offers competitive pay in the range of \$20-35/hour, commensurate with experience.
- D. The positions will, in total, amount to at least one full time internship during the 2017 calendar year. However, internship work on a part time basis is available immediately in all of the areas designated in the qualifications.
